WORD OF GOD SUNDAY

The Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, *this year, January 21st*, we celebrate the Sunday of the Word of God recognizing the centrality of God's word in the life of the church. St. Jerome, who translated most of the Bible into Latin in the fourth century, wrote, "Ignorance of the scriptures is ignorance of Christ." Every time we come to Mass we listen to the words of scripture, conscious that God's word is a living word, speaking to us in our age as powerfully and relevantly as when it was written. Let us resolve to make God's word a guiding force in our lives.

Be sure to take notice of our Lectionaries enshrined in the entrance of the Church.
