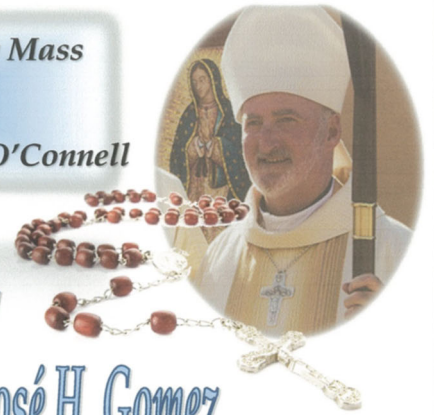

**PRESENTATION
OF THE LORD
FEBRUARY 2ND**

Why do Catholics celebrate the feast of the Presentation?

This feast day celebrates both the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple, as well as the Purification of Mary, which was required by the Mosaic Law forty days after the birth of a child.

The Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2, also called Candlemas for the custom of using lighted candles. In the early Church it was often celebrated on February 14th, 40 days after the Epiphany, in keeping with the practice of celebrating Christmas on that date in the East. Among the Orthodox it is known as the Hypapante ("Meeting" of the Lord with Simeon).

**ST. BLAISE,
SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 3RD**

In memory of St. Blaise, the Blessing of Throats will be given at the 8:00 am Mass.

St. Blaise was the Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia in the early 4th century. While little is known of his life, he is believed to have been martyred during the persecution of Christians. He was said to also be a physician. One story handed down to us says that he miraculously saved a boy who was choking to death on a fish bone. To this day we still celebrate St. Blaise's feast day on February 3rd with the Blessing of Throats. Two candles joined together in the shape of a cross are then touched to our throats as St. Blaise is invoked to intercede for us that God may deliver us from diseases of the throat and all other illnesses.

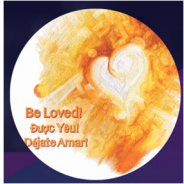
