It is important for caregivers to remember that some seemingly positive changes could also be signs of abuse, such as when a child tries to “be perfect” so as to avoid a feared consequence or in some way “control” circumstances so as to avoid or minimize further exposure to a traumatic situation. Why are children with disabilities at risk?

Children with disabilities are at higher risk for maltreatment and abuse.
