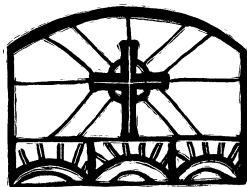

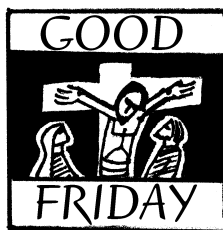

**Foot Washing:  
Come Ready and Willing**

Have you ever wondered how we might be different as a community of faith if the central gesture we continued each Sunday in response to Jesus' Last Supper command: "Do this in memory of me" had been the washing of feet instead of the sharing of food and drink? In the Holy Thursday liturgy, these two actions of grace---the blessing and sharing of bread and wine and the washing of feet---go to the heart of what it means to be a follower of Jesus. Both are intimately connected to the other. The eucharist not only prepares us for service but compels us to service. Washing feet is the requirement and the logical conclusion of our partaking in the eucharist.

Washing feet is not merely a nice symbol but a vivid example and expression of what we are called to as Catholic Christians. Once a year as a community of believers, as a people claiming to be eucharistic, we participate intentionally and reverently in the washing of each others feet. Just as we prayerfully process forward to venerate the cross on Good Friday, so too on Holy Thursday we come forward as imitators of Christ, not to play-act or mimic this silently loud action, but to remind ourselves that this is what our faith demands of us. This is who we are: eager servants on bended knee with towel and water bowl in our hands.

In order to clear up any confusion, we want to make sure that you know **that on Holy Thursday, April 13th at 7:30 pm, EACH and EVERY person who desires to come forward and participate in the foot washing is encouraged to do so.** Consider wearing shoes that are easy to remove and put on--sandals or loafers.

Women might want to leave their stockings at home. As people make their way to the foot washing stations, please support this humble, loving gesture by praying in song. While reverent, please keep the lines moving and make your way to the nearest station.

Like the distribution of ashes on Ash Wednesday, like the veneration of the cross on Good Friday, we wash each other's feet but once a year. Let us not miss the moment or be impatient with it. It is a fitting beginning to Triduum. After all, we are people of the cross and resurrection.

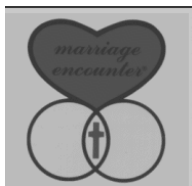

**PLANNING FOR FUTURE PASTORAL  
NEEDS OF ST. JOHN VIANNEY PARISH**

How would parishes in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles function if there was no priest-pastor available to serve? What would parishes do if they were consolidated or clustered with one or more neighboring parishes?

These are among questions St. John Vianney and other parishes in the Archdiocese are being asked to reflect on, discuss, and answer in an important study being conducted throughout the Archdiocese. The study entitled - The Parish Organization Planning Report - is a means to assess and plan for future pastoral needs of the Archdiocese and each individual parish.

Members of the Pastoral and Finance Councils are presently assessing the most significant strengths or characteristics of our parish, and its most pressing needs. They will then consider and rank six possible alternatives that would best provide for the spiritual and pastoral needs of the parish if there was only one fulltime priest, or if there was none:

- ♦ **Consolidation** (parish no longer viable as a fully operative parish and could be consolidated with another parish)
- ♦ **Twinning** (one pastor with two or more autonomous parishes)
- ♦ **Clustering** (two or more pastors or Parish Life Directors with semi-autonomous parishes)
- ♦ **Parish Life Director** (Deacon, Religious, Lay Person, but not a Priest)
- ♦ **Ethnic/Culture Center** (parish converted to an ethnic or cultural ministry center)
- ♦ **Closure** (parish no longer viable and should be closed)

Our response to this study is due Thursday, June 1, 2006. The answers from 288 parishes will be tabulated and discussed in November, 2006 at a conference led by Cardinal Roger Mahony and the Archdiocesan leadership team. Survey results will be made available to all parishes.

The Parish Organization Planning Report is not optional. It is required. All parish members are asked to participate in the assessment and planning for the future pastoral needs of St. John Vianney Parish.

A PARISH TOWN HALL MEETING will be held on Tuesday, May 16th at 7:30 pm in the O'Callaghan Center. All parish members are requested to attend and reflect on the strengths of the parish and how to best provide for its spiritual and pastoral needs.
