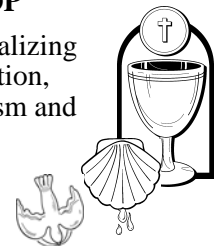

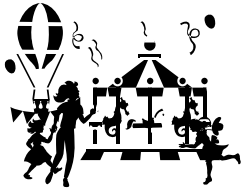

### PLANNING FOR FUTURE PASTORAL LEADERSHIP OF OUR PARISH

An important parish town Hall meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 16th at 7:30 pm in the O'Callaghan Center. All parish members are invited to attend, reflect on the strengths of St. John Vianney parish, and provide input on how to best provide for future spiritual and pastoral needs. Two questions need to be considered:

1. With the likelihood that the parishes of our Archdiocese will have fewer priests in the coming years, how will our parish provide for pastoral ministry and pastoral leadership?

2. What model of parish leadership would be best for our parish if a resident priest pastor is not available?

¿Que modelo de liderazgo pastoral, seria el mejor para nuestra parroquia si no tuviera ya un sacerdote resident?

You will be asked to participate fully in visioning our parish with just one priest, probably the pastor. How do we continue to keep our parish alive and dynamic with just one priest? How do we coordinate all of our parish ministries and services? What kind of model might work best for us if we had no full time priest? Clustering with one or two other parishes? Sharing a priest with another parish?

How will we best provide for the spiritual and pastoral needs of the parish if there was ONE full time priest, or if there were NO full time priests. To that end, you will be presented with three possible scenarios to consider and rank in order of preference:

**1) Twinning** (one pastor with two or more autonomous parishes) **2) Clustering** (one or more pastors or Parish Life Directors with semi-autonomous parishes) **3) Parish Life Director** (Deacon, Religious, Lay Person, but not a priest).

The Town Hall meeting should produce a good basis for envisioning future parish ministry in St. John Vianney Parish. The goal of this process is to challenge our parish leaders and parishioners to keep our parish alive and dynamic in the coming years, regardless of the number of active priests available to us.
