Special Collection - Retirement Fund for Archdiocesan Priests - May 20-21

There are currently 162 Archdiocesan Priests who are retired. During the next ten years, we are expecting that an additional 220 priests -- who are actively serving in the Archdiocese today -- will reach 65 years of age.

The primary source of income for retired priests is the Priest Pension Plan, which was formally established in 1993. Like Religious Orders of men and women, so little was put into Social Security in the past, very little is received each month by way of a Social Security Check. As a matter of justice, we increased the amount of monthly pension benefits for retired priests in 2005 so that our priests who are retired will have some security about their care.

The necessary increases in benefits for retired priests make it essential that our annual appeal realize at least \$1,000,000. Thank you for your generosity this weekend.
