**A Note from the Pastor - -**

Congratulations!! The May 16th Parish Town Hall Meeting was a successful and collaborative effort and commitment on the part of the parish staff, members of the Pastoral and Finance Councils, and approximately 160 parish members who came together to address the significant issue of how best to provide for future pastoral needs of our parish.

The preferences for anticipated pastoral needs expressed at the Town Hall meeting, from among the choices available, have been incorporated in the required Parish Organization Planning Report, dated May 26, 2006, and submitted to the Archdiocesan Office.

This report, along with similar reports from each parish in the Archdiocese will be used as a basis for the Archdiocesan planning session scheduled by Cardinal Mahony, the auxiliary bishops, and the Archdiocesan Leadership Team for November, 2006. At that meeting the issue of how best to provide for future pastoral needs of the Archdiocese will be addressed.

The interest and participation of parish members in the development of the Parish Organization Planning Report is greatly appreciated.

A copy of the complete report is available for review in the Corpus Christi Center.
