**A NOTE FROM OUR NEW PRIEST**

I grew up in the Philippines and came to the United States in the latter part of 1987 with my parents and my sister. My home parish is St. Bernard Church in Bellflower, having lived in the city when we first came over. Even after moving to the neighboring city of Paramount, we continue to call St. Bernard our parish.

After starting college at Cerritos Community College, I transferred to California State University in Long Beach where I earned a Bachelor's Degree in Computer Science-Engineering Option in May of 1994. This led to a three-year stint in Long Beach as a software developer and system administrator for a Silicon Valley-based company engaged in electronic design automation.

When the company decided to move north, I stayed in Southern California working another three years as a software developer for a company involved in military contracts. During that time, thoughts of priesthood -- long-suppressed in my high-school days--began to come back. After a substantial period of discernment, I was accepted by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles to attend St. John's Seminary and be formed as a priest.

I was blessed to belong to a diverse class which was composed of seminarian brothers from Los Angeles, Orange, San Diego, Monterey, Seattle, Kampala, Kiyinda-Mityana (both from Uganda), and the Missionaries of the Holy Spirit. My year-long internship (during the 2003-2004) academic year) at St. Joseph Church in Hawthorne, confirmed my desire to be with the people of God in a multicultural parish setting. By the grace of God, I was ordained to the order of the Diaconate in November of 2005 and, at age 35, to the order of the Priesthood on the 3rd of June, 2006.
