PASTOR'S CORNER

There is something invigorating about the Fall season, about the excitement of starting a new school year, about new beginnings in our daily lives.

Our School of Religion is off to a very good start, with about 850 children and youth, from Kindergarten to High School enrolled in English and Spanish catechism-based instruction. About 80 parents, desiring to continue in their own faith formation, also attend weekly sessions of lectionary and catechism-based classes. In addition, about 125 families attend family catechesis sessions on Sundays.

Inquiry phase of our RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) program has welcomed over 64 persons interested in learning about our Catholic faith, since the weekly RCIA session began on Tuesday, September 5th. Today, good adult religious education is sorely needed to provide everyone the opportunity to grow spiritually, to be prayerful, and to become involved in the life and mission of the Church.

The Adult Faith Formation Board reviews all proposals for adult religious education. It has established a Master Calendar to coordinate all adult religious programs with those offered by our parish Religious Formation program and RCIA.

All proposals, both English and Spanish, for adult religious education programs, from any of the priests, parish ministry organizations, or individuals, should be presented to the Adult Faith Formation Board for review. Proposals should be faith-filled, and include particulars about the topic, such as subject matter, the presenter(s), materials required, time schedule, dates proposed, and facilities needed. Examples of materials, such as books, workbooks, and handouts, should be provided.

The goal of the Adult Faith Formation Board is to bring the entire parish community into faith formation by coordinating liturgy, faith, and parish life in religious education.

This can be done by implementing the whole community catechesis process in all faith formation programs. Each program, meeting, class, workshop, or event will begin with the scriptural reading of the day, or the question of the week, to be followed by a few moments of prayerful reflection and/or sharing and fellowship before the planned program begins.

Whole Community Catechesis will help us to come to a deeper knowledge of Christ, invite us to celebrate the reality of Christ in our lives, and gather together with others, to celebrate, to praise, and to worship as a community of believers.

IMPORTANT INFO TO ALL PARISHIONERS

THE Pension Protection Act of 2006 has amended the substantiation/record keeping requirements for donations made by cash or check.

Effective immediately - all cash donations, regardless of amount, must be substantiated by either a bank record (cancelled check) or written statement from the recipient charity. "Other written records" will no longer be accepted by IRS. What does this mean to SJV Parishioners?? In order for St. John Vianney to substantiate a cash or check donation, the donation must be enclosed in an offering envelope with the parishioner's name, address, registration number, and donation amount written on the outside of the envelope.
