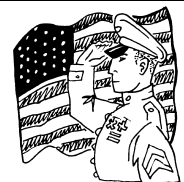

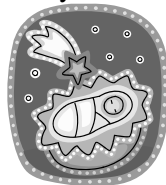

### **DID YOU KNOW?**

#### **Children Do Not Lie About Abuse**

Most children are not lying when they say that they were abused. Less than 5 percent of all allegations are intentionally false. It is more likely that children will refuse to tell about abuse than to lie about abuse. Several studies estimate that only about 6 percent of all children report sexual abuse by an adult to someone who can do something about it. The other 94 percent do not tell anyone or talk only to a friend. (And they swear their friend to secrecy). #### **Who Are the Abusers**

Estimates are that approximately 60 percent of abusers are men, 15 to 20 percent are women, and 20 to 40 percent are men and women acting together. So, while men are indeed the majority of sexual abusers, it is dangerous to underestimate the risk that female sexual abusers also pose to children. Among educators, 57.2 percent of abusers are male and 42.4 percent of abusers are female. To learn more about creating safe environments in the school and home, please contact...

#### **Los Niños No Mienten Sobre el Abuso**

La mayoría de los niños no están mintiendo cuando dicen que los abusaron. Menos de cinco por ciento de todas las alegaciones son intencionalmente falsas. Es más probable que los niños rechacen hablar del abuso que mentir sobre el abuso. Varios estudios estiman que solamente cerca de 6 por ciento de todos los niños abusados por un adulto le cuentan sobre el abuso sexual a alguien que puede hacer algo sobre él. Los otros 94 por ciento no le dicen a cualquier persona, y usualmente hablan solamente con un amigo y lo hacen jurar a no contar el secreto a nadie más. #### **Quiénes Son Los Abusadores**

Se estima que el 60% de los abusadores son hombres, que del 15 al 20 % son mujeres, y que del 20 al 40 % son hombres y mujeres actuando juntos. Así mientras los hombres son la mayoría de los abusadores sexuales, sería peligroso rebajar el riesgo que suponen para los niños las abusadoras sexuales. Entre educadores, el 57.2 % son hombres, mientras que el 42.4 % son mujeres.
