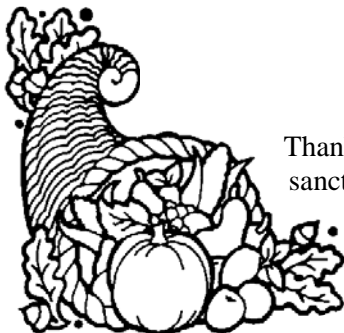

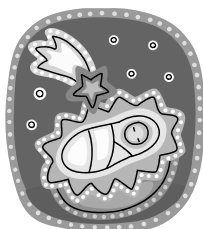


St. Vincent de Paul is once again coordinating this program for our parish.
