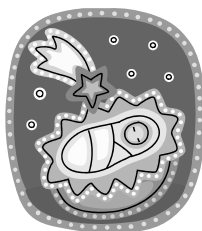


St. Vincent de Paul is once again coordinating this program for our parish.

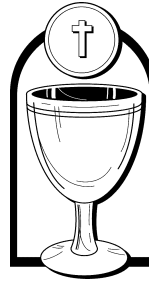

**TOGETHER IN MISSION IS NEARING THE END**

The final billings for the 2006 *Together in Mission* campaign are now being sent in November and December to those who still have a balance due on their pledges. Our parishioners have already pledged **\$141,315.29** (113%) and have contributed **\$123,323.29**, but we still must contribute **\$1,491.01** more to reach our cash goal of **\$124,814.30**. If we do not reach our parish goal in cash received, we will need to pay the difference from our normal parish operating funds.
