Lent is Coming!

“The Lenten season has a double character; the catechumens...are preparing for the celebration of the sacraments of Christian Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist) at the Easter Vigil; the faithful...prepare themselves by penance for the renewal of their Baptismal promises at Easter (Ceremonial of Bishops, 249).”

Lent runs from Ash Wednesday until the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. As a sign of our own mortality and that we, along with all our brothers and sisters in Christ, are willing to be part of this Lenten journey we receive ashes on our forehead. As we receive them, the priest, Deacon or Eucharistic minister says: **“Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel”**.

As the Scripture readings for Ash Wednesday suggest, the focus of Lent is on prayer, fasting and sharing with those in need --- not just “giving something up for Lent”. The Friday after Ash Wednesday reminds us that “this is the fasting that I wish: releasing those bound unjustly; untying the thongs of the yoke; setting free the oppressed; breaking every yoke; sharing your bread with the hungry; sheltering the oppressed and the homeless; clothing the naked when you see them --- and not turning your back on your own!” (Is. 58).

ASH WEDNESDAY AND ALL THE FRIDAYS OF LENT are also days of abstinence from meat **for all Catholics 14 and older.**

In addition, **ON ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY, all persons from age 18-59** are asked to fast (health permitting). This means taking only one full (meatless) meal a day. Two other small meals and/or milk and fruit juice are also permitted in order to maintain strength for everyday responsibilities.

The Church **“challenges us to a spirit of sacrifice”** during Lent by fasting and abstinence. However, **failure to fast or abstain are not sinful acts.** That is — it is **not** a sin to eat meat on Friday.

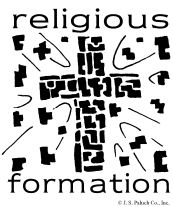

According to the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, the latest national survey confirms there are now more than 374,270 registered sex offenders nationwide in the United States. California has the largest number of registered sex offenders of any state, due to its lifetime sex offender registration requirement and a population exceeding an estimated 35 million residents. Since 1996, individuals have had access at police stations to the names and addresses of registered sex offenders in California. On January 1, 2005, this information became available to anyone through a government website. The website contains an excellent summary of Megan's Law and its implications.
