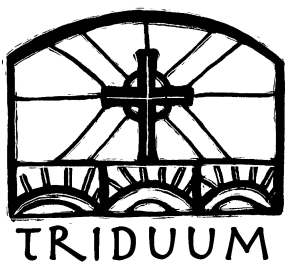

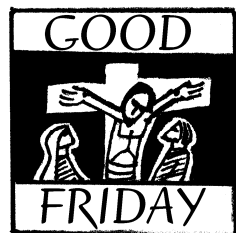

**Foot Washing:
Come Ready and Willing**

Have you ever wondered how we might be different as a community of faith if the central gesture we continued each Sunday in response to Jesus' Last Supper command: "Do this in memory of me" had been the washing of feet instead of the sharing of food and drink? In the Holy Thursday liturgy, these two actions of grace---the blessing and sharing of bread and wine and the washing of feet--- go to the heart of what it means to be a follower of Jesus. Both are intimately connected to the other. The eucharist not only prepares us for service but compels us to service. Washing feet is the requirement and the logical conclusion of our partaking in the eucharist.

Washing feet is not merely a nice symbol but a vivid example and expression of what we are called to as Catholic Christians. Once a year as a community of believers, as a people claiming to be eucharistic, we participate intentionally and reverently in the washing of each others feet. Just as we prayerfully process forward to venerate the cross on Good Friday, so too on Holy Thursday we come forward as imitators of Christ, not to play-act or mimic this silently loud action, but to remind ourselves that this is what our faith demands of us. This is who we are: eager servants on bended knee with towel and water bowl in our hands.

In order to clear up any confusion, we want to make sure that you know **that on Holy Thursday, April 5th at 7:30 pm, EACH and EVERY person who desires to come forward and participate in the foot washing is encouraged to do so.** Consider wearing shoes that are easy to remove and put on--sandals or loafers.

Women might want to leave their stockings at home. As people make their way to the foot washing stations, please support this humble, loving gesture by praying in song. While reverent, please keep the lines moving and make your way to the nearest station.

Like the distribution of ashes on Ash Wednesday, like the veneration of the cross on Good Friday, we wash each other's feet but once a year. Let us not miss the moment or be impatient with it. It is a fitting beginning to Triduum. After all, we are people of the cross and resurrection.
