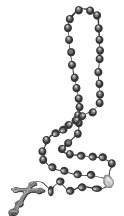

Physician-assisted suicide bill AB374 has passed the Assembly Judiciary Committee by party-line vote: Dem. 7 Yes, Rep. 3 No. Assemblyman Charles Calderon may soon be voting on AB 374 in the full State Assembly. Mr. Calderon needs to hear from you now!
