ST. JOHN SEMINARY NEWSLETTER

Each year, the seminary community changes and is blessed by the presence of new members. I thank God for each of our seminarians, and for the members of their families, their friends, the priests and others who have been influential in nurturing their vocations.

Frequently, I am asked about the number of seminarians and their backgrounds. So let me offer some information about our seminary community. This year there are 92 seminarians enrolled in St. John's, and an additional 29 students who are enrolled in our programs for a Master of Arts or a Master of Arts in Pastoral Ministry. The seminarians are preparing for service in the following dioceses and communities:

- 13 for the Diocese of Orange
- 7 for the Diocese of Fresno
- 5 for the Missionaries of the Holy Spirit
- 4 for the Oblates of St. Joseph

- 2 for the Vincentians
- 2 for the Archdiocese of Kampala, Uganda
- 2 for the Diocese of Kiyinda-Mityana, Uganda
- 2 for the Diocese of Tshumbe, Democratic Republic of the Congo
- 1 for the Order of Augustinian Recollects
- 1 for the Caroline Islands

Our seminarians range in age between 21 and 65. we enjoy a wonderful multiethnic community, with men born in 19 different countries and from many different ethnic backgrounds including anglo-American, Hispanic, Vietnamese, Korean, Filipino, Nigerian, Congolese, Ugandan, Pacific Islands, and Indonesian (among others). Each brings gifts rooted in the religious traditions of their cultures.
