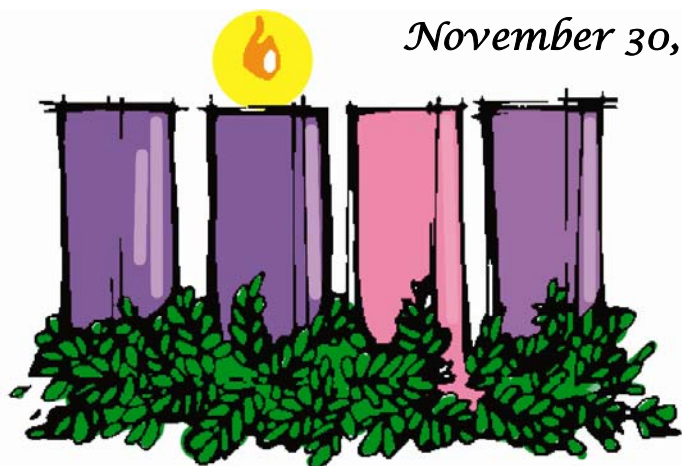

RITE OF ACCEPTANCE AND WELCOME

During the 10 am Mass last Sunday, our parish celebrated the Rite of Acceptance and Welcome for Adult inquirers in the RCIA process who are preparing to complete Sacraments of Initiation in the Catholic Church. The Rite of Acceptance is for those who are preparing to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation. They publicly declared their intention to continue their Journey towards becoming Catholics and declared their Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens. The Rite of Welcome is for inquirers who have been previously baptized and publicly declared their intention to continue their Journey toward full communion with the Catholic Church. This group of Catechumens and Candidates were signed with the Cross to show that they belong to Christ.
