Mission Cooperative Appeal August 19 & 20

Next weekend we will have a special Mission speaker, Fr. Rudy Valenzuela, fsp who is the founder and CEO of *Clinica Santa Maria de Guadalupe* – a ministry of the Friars of the Sick Poor of Los Angeles in San Luis Rio Colorado, Sonora, Mexico. Their mission is to redeem human suffering and carry out Jesus' mission of healing the sick and caring for those most in need. They do this by providing affordable and compassionate access to healthcare service to the underserved population of San Luis and its vicinities. They are the only healthcare facility within a 30-minute ratio, making the clinic a necessary stop for families who do not have transportation or the ability to pay for costlier services. They have also become a hub for emergencies among a population who cannot easily afford specialized medical care and are unable to easily access healthcare services. Funds obtained from this mission appeal will go directly to purchase and upgrade emergency, inpatient, and surgical equipment, as well as to offset some of the expenses incurred when patients are unable to pay for more complicated services and procedures. Su misión es redimir el sufrimiento humano y llevar a cabo la misión de Jesús de curar a los enfermos y cuidar a los más necesitados. Ellos pueden hacer esto proporcionando viviendas asequibles y compasivas a los servicios de salud a la población desatendida de San Luis y sus alrededores. Es el único centro de salud dentro de un área de treinta minutos que sirve como una parada necesaria para las familias que no tienen transporte o la capacidad de pagar los servicios más costosos. También se ha convertido en un centro para las emergencias para los que no pueden pagar fácilmente la atención médica especializada o tener a su alcance los servicios de salud. Los fondos recaudados de este Llamamiento a la Misión se destinarán directamente a la compra y la actualización de los equipos de emergencia y quirúrgicos, y para los pacientes hospitalizados, y también para aliviar algunos de los gastos incurridos cuando los pacientes no pueden pagar los servicios y procedimientos más complicados. DID YOU KNOW?

What to do if a child discloses abuse to a peer

Abuse victims often struggle to disclose what has happened to them, especially children. This struggle may be due to fear or shame, but studies show it is easier for children to disclose abuse to a trusted person. In adolescence, that is often another peer. This makes it important to educate children about what to do if a friend discloses abuse. Teach children the importance of not keeping unsafe secrets, and how to help their friends by sharing these "secrets" with a trusted parent or other adult. ¿Qué debe hacer un niño si otro menor le revela que ha sido abusado?

Las víctimas de abuso a menudo tienen dificultades para revelar lo que les ha sucedido, especialmente a otros niños. Esta lucha puede deberse a miedo o a vergüenza, pero estudios muestran que es más fácil para los niños revelar el abuso a una persona de confianza. En la adolescencia, esta persona de confianza suele ser una persona de su misma edad. Esto conduce a la importancia de educar a los niños sobre qué hacer si un amigo le revela que ha sido abusado. Enséñele a los niños la importancia de no guardar secretos de inseguridad, y cómo ayudar a sus amigos compartiendo estos "secretos" con un padre de familia de confianza o con otro adulto de confianza. OCC Rooms 15 & 16 expansion
Replacing plumbing in Rectory

As a lot of us know, construction projects usually run into a myriad of unexpected obstacles. Our beloved church structures are no different! The rectory plumbing is in the process of being tested for asbestos before the estimates are finalized and any work can be started. Expansion of OCC Rooms 15 & 16 has presented a problem with electrical wiring inside the wall to be taken down. Further architectural/engineering review is needed to complete the estimate process.

La plomería de la rectoría está en proceso de prueba de asbesto antes de que se finalicen las estimaciones y se pueda comenzar cualquier trabajo. La expansión de los salones 15 y 16 de OCC ha presentado un problema con el cableado eléctrico dentro de la pared que se va a desmontar. Se necesita una revisión adicional de arquitectura/ingeniería para completar el proceso de estimación.
