GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEP- ER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

Matthew 4:12-23

I was 22 years old, lying in bed one night while on a pilgrimage, when I suddenly sensed an idea in my mind: "Go to the seminary." There was no voice, no vision, but a gentle and unmistakable clarity. I simply prayed, "Lord, if that's from you, let me find great joy in it." Three days later, my heart was bursting with joy. I dropped everything and entered the seminary. The older I get, the stranger my rather careless and hasty departure seems to me. I followed not because it made sense, or because I was especially brave. I went because the Lord called me.

Something like this happens in today's Gospel. Jesus walks by Simon, Andrew, James, and John and says, "**Come after me**" (Matthew 4:19). And *immediately* they leave their nets and follow. There's no explanation, no hesitation ... just movement. Why? As St. John says, "**In this is love: not that we have loved God, but that he loved us**" (1 John 4:10). They do not leave their nets because his call made perfect, calculable sense. They left them because they were called. And Jesus' call is powerful.

Take a moment this week to remember when Christ first called you. However small or quiet it was, recall it, and give thanks. The more we marvel that Christ has called us personally, the more passionately and freely we will follow him.

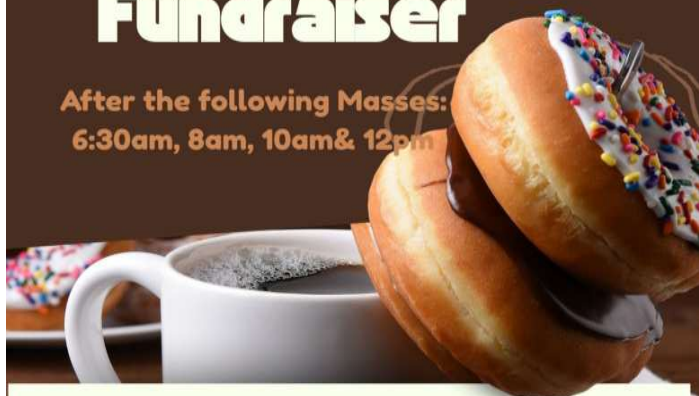

DID YOU KNOW?

Far-reaching effects of child abuse

Children who suffer from sexual abuse run a greater risk of negative associated outcomes, not only with their mental health, but also suicidal tendencies, potential future abuse, more cognitive deficits, or lower educational interests and efforts. Abused children also are at higher risk for eating disorders, obesity, early onset of puberty, or chronic health issues. Ultimately, abuse has far-reaching consequences beyond childhood for many victims, and it is critical to act quickly to protect potential victims. It's important to remember that any intervention or supportive response from a safe adult can reduce the risk of many or all negative outcomes. What makes a child feel safe enough to disclose abuse?

There are several factors that contribute to whether a child is comfortable disclosing abuse to an adult. Children are more likely to talk about problems when they: have access to an adult they can trust; are able to understand that what is happening to them is not normal or safe; and trust that they will be believed. Another factor that may help a child disclose abuse is when a safe adult is intentional and asks direct questions about a child's life as it communicates caring and attention to the child's life circumstances. Explaining sexual abuse to school-aged children

School-aged children should be taught about the dangers of sexual abuse, and the signs of risky situations that could lead to potential abuse. Sexual abuse and exploitation does not only happen through in-person touch; it can happen online or through the phone as well. For this reason, it's important that children know what is and is not okay for adults and others to do. Risky situations can include being asked to send photos, or being contacted by someone you don't know online. Efectos al largo plazo del maltrato a los menores

Los niños que sufren abusos sexuales corren un mayor riesgo de sufrir consecuencias negativas, no solo en su salud mental, sino también en forma de tendencias suicidas, posibles abusos futuros, más déficits cognitivos o menor interés y esfuerzo en los estudios. Los niños maltratados también corren un mayor riesgo de sufrir trastornos alimentarios, obesidad, pubertad precoz o problemas de salud crónicos. Es importante recordar que cualquier intervención o respuesta de apoyo por parte de un adulto de confianza puede reducir el riesgo de muchos o todos los resultados negativos. ¿Qué hace que un niño se sienta bastante seguro para revelar un abuso?

Hay varios factores que contribuyen a que un niño se sienta cómodo revelando un abuso a un adulto. Es más probable que los niños hablen de sus problemas cuando: tienen acceso a un adulto en quien pueden confiar; son capaces de entender que lo que les ocurre no es normal ni seguro; y confían que serán creídos. Otro factor que puede ayudar a un niño a revelar un abuso es cuando un adulto seguro actúa con intención y hace preguntas directas sobre la vida de un niño, transmite cariño y atención a las circunstancias de la vida del niño. Cómo explicar el abuso sexual a los niños en edad escolar

Hay que enseñar a los niños en edad escolar los peligros del abuso sexual y las señales de situaciones de riesgo que podrían conducir a un posible abuso. El abuso y la explotación sexuales no sólo se producen mediante el contacto en persona; también pueden ocurrir por el internet o por teléfono. Es importante que los niños conozcan los comportamientos adecuados e inadecuados de los adultos. Las situaciones de riesgo pueden incluir pedir a un niño que le envíe fotos o que alguien desconocido se ponga en contacto por el internet.
